CAFÉ ÉLAN

Café Élan, located inside the Château across from the Wine Market has a cosmopolitan ambience evoking images of those cozy provincial restaurants scattered through Europe. Café Élan captures the cooking and tastes of Mediterranean dishes from the culinary diversity found along its bountiful coastlines. Open seven days a week for lunch 11:00am - 4:00pm and dinner 5:00pm -10:00pm. Reservations recommended.

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FLEUR DE LIS

Located in the Spa mansion at Château Élan, this lovely restaurant overlooking a small lake offers seasonal gourmet dishes prepared by the spa's own chef. Afternoon tea with tasty snacks served from 4:00-5:30pm. Open seven days a week for breakfast and lunch. Friday and Saturday for dinner.

PADDY'S IRISH PUB

Paddy's Irish Pub was commissioned in Dublin in 1997 by Château Élan founders, Dr. Donald and Nancy Panoz. Cantrell & Crowley, a Dublin based architectural and interior design firm designed and built the pub. Paddy's was shipped to Château Élan with all its furnishings and fixtures, opening in 1997. A full range of Irish and American fare ranging from Bangers & Mash, Fish & Chips, Fried Chicken Wings with Paddy's Green sauce, Corned Beef, and Shepherd's Pie, to Grilled Salmon, Marinated Sirloin and Irish Lamb Stew along with a great selection of traditional Irish beverages in a spirited neighborhood atmosphere. Live entertainment Friday and Saturday, starting at 8:30pm. Open Monday - Thursday 2:00pm until 1am. Friday & Saturday, Noon till 1:00am, and Sunday 12:00pm till Midnight.

GOLF CLUBHOUSE GRILLE

All-American fare. Indoor and porch dining rooms with picture windows overlooking Château golf course. Full-breakfast with eggs, omelets, pancakes, with bacon, sausage or ham, hash browns, and breakfast burritos.
